**Common Causes of Cycling Collisions:**

- A motor vehicle driver turning directly in front of a bicyclist;
- A motor vehicle driver entering the street from a driveway or parking lot, pulling out into traffic in front of the bicyclist;
- A motorist’s failure to yield at an intersection and/or running a stop sign or red light;
- A motorist’s inattention while driving past a bicyclist;
- A motorist’s failure to look both ways when resuming travel after stopping at a stop sign; and
- A motor vehicle driver is under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
